

## HIGH PLAINS FAIR HOUSING



High Plains Fair Housing Center has openings on its Board of Directors.

The mission of the High Plains Fair Housing Center is to strengthen communities and to ensure equal access to fair housing in the region through training, education, enforcement and advocacy.

Fair Housing is a right protected by federal and state laws. Fair Housing means you may freely choose a place to live without regard to your race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or because you have a disability; have children in your family; or because you are on public assistance.

High Plains is the only organization in the state of North Dakota whose mission is to fight housing discrimination. It is based in Grand Forks and covers the entire state of North Dakota. Board members who do not live in Grand Forks may participate by conference call.

### Responsibilities/Qualifications:

Directors provide guidance in the direction of the organization in adhering to its mission of fighting for fair housing – an important basic civil right.

Each director is asked to attend board meetings regularly (monthly) and serve actively on a board committee. Board members advocate for the High Plains Fair Housing Center in the community and have a commitment to Fair Housing.
