Vocational Rehabilitation Financial Need Criteria

Financial Need Criteria

- Must specify which services will be subject to financial need
- Must consider disability-related expenses
- Must not be so high as to effectively deny an individual a necessary service
- Exempt services
 - Diagnostic services
 - Counseling, guidance, and referral services
 - lob placement
 - Personal assistance services
 - Auxiliary aids and services such as interpreters and readers
- SSDI and SSI recipients, including 1619(b) Medicaid are exempt. They should not be required to participate in the cost of VR services.

Comparable Benefits

- VR agencies are considered the payer of last resort for many services
- VR will not pay for a service if a similar or comparable benefit is available through another provider.
- For example, if person qualifies for services through Medicaid, VR will not provide the service.
- The comparable benefit must be available at the time needed.

Exemptions From Comparable Benefit Requirements

Student loans which must Scholarships and awards SSI's Plan for Achieving based on merit be repaid

Self-Support (PASS)

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
