Vocational Rehabilitation Service Options

Required services available through Vocational Rehabilitation:

- Assessment(s) to determine eligibility and needs
- Counseling, guidance, and job placement services
- Referrals to the services of WIOA providers, if appropriate
- Vocational and other training, including higher education and the purchase of tools, materials, and books
- Diagnosis and treatment of physical or mental impairments to reduce or eliminate impediments to employment, to the extent that support is not available from other sources
- Maintenance for additional costs incurred during rehabilitation
- Personal assistance services while receiving VR services
- Transportation including adequate training in use of public transportation vehicles and systems, provided in connection with the provision of any other service described in this section and needed by the individual to achieve an employment outcome
- Transportation may include vehicle purchase
- Interpreter services for individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing
- Supported employment
- Services to the family to assist an individual with a disability to achieve an employment outcome
- Other goods or services necessary to achieve employment outcome
- Post-employment services to help retain, regain, or advance in employment
- Not intended to be complex or comprehensive
